## REGULATIONS

of the rhythmic gymnastics tournament  
for individuals and groups

**International tournament I**  
**"For Olympic Champion Anastasia Tatareva's Award"**

## **1. Purposes and objectives:**

Rhythmic gymnastics competition International tournament I.

The purposes of the tournament "For Olympic Champion Anastasia Tatareva's Award" in individual and group routines (hereinafter the "competition") are:

- promote healthy lifestyle;
- popularise rhythmic gymnastics;
- attract athletes of high international class to Sverdlovsk Oblast;
- reveal the strongest gymnasts;
- strengthen bonds with the sports community;
- exchange experience between coaches.

The competition is organised in accordance with the regulations of "rhythmic gymnastics" approved with the order of the Russian Ministry of Sports (hereinafter the "RMoS"), dated 21 Dec. 2018 N 1068, as amended with the order by the RMoS, dated 28 May 2019 N 417.

The competition meets the regulations on the official organization of sports events in the Russian Federation under the risks of spreading COVID-19, dated 31 Aug. 2020.

## **2. Venue and date:**

The competition is held on **7 - 8 May 2021**,

## **3. The organizer:**

The competition organizer is Sverdlovsk physical education and sports public organization "Rhythmic Gymnastics Federation" in association with the local public organization "Yekaterinburg Rhythmic Gymnastics Federation No. 1" under the agreement on collaboration and joint activity N 1-21, dated 15 Mar. 21.

The responsible for safety and public order maintenance in the sport facilities are the local public organization "Yekaterinburg Rhythmic Gymnastics Federation No. 1", the sports facilities owner and participants. All the measures are implemented in accordance with Russian Federation legislation.

This competition is sponsored by a sponsor company.

## **4. Management of the competition:**

## **5. Participants and audience safety**

The competition is organised in accordance with the Federal Law 329-FZ, dated 04 Dec. 2007, "On physical education and sport in the Russian Federation".

The sport facilities meet the requirements of the relevant safety and public order legislation of the Russian Federation and have technical verification certificates which prove their appropriateness for this type of events. The owner of the sport facilities which are used for the competition provides appropriate technical equipment for the competition venue, in accordance with technical regulations, national standards and requirements prescribed by federal regulatory authorities and sanitary

regulations, and takes responsibility for any harm to life and health of the person performing sports activity at mentioned sports facilities in accordance with Russian Federation legislation.

The responsible for the implementation of safety rules and regulations during the competition are:

a responsible for the sports equipment.

## 6. Competitors requirements

The competition is to be held according the effective FIG rules, dated 2017-2021.

Athletes without any medical conditions are allowed only. All participants must have casualty insurance (in case of an accident which leads to loss of performance ability).

A medical certificates with an ink stamp and the original copy of an insurance contract must be forwarded to the competition judges.

## 8. Results

Results are scored in points. The winner of each age group has the highest score in all-around. If two or more gymnasts have equal all-around score, the judges give preference to the gymnast gained higher skill assessments.

The winner in group all-around has the highest score. If two or more teams have equal score, the judges give preference to the team gained higher skill assessments.

## 9. Awards

The competition winners are to be awarded with cups, medals and certificates; the prize winners are to be awarded with medals and certificates; all participants are to be awarded with certificates of participation and souvenirs.

The couches of the competition winners in individual and group routines are to be awarded with certificates. All couches and participants are to be awarded with souvenirs.

## 10. Financing

The competition is financed with the sponsorship and registration and entry fee (see annex 1).

All travel expenses for participants, couches and official representatives must be paid by seconding organizations.

Individual registration forms certified by a doctor and a director of sports organization, a copy of a passport or the copy of a birth certificate (for athletes under the age of 14), judging certificates with verified judging rating, proving the judge's familiarity with new FIG regulations, dated 2017-2021, must be forwarded to the mandates commission of the competition.

Teams which will not confirm their participation on time will not be allowed to compete.
